## Years 7 to 11:

- Black blazer with embroidered school badge to be worn at all times (available from Famous School branches only).
- Knee-length black pleated skirt with gold band or tailored black trousers (available from Famous School branches only)
- Black V-neck pullover with magenta stripe (available from Famous School branches only).
- School tie (available from Famous School branches only) or Chorister's tie, to be tied up to collar and normal length.
- Plain white shirt/blouse with buttons to the neck and standard collar.
- Black or skin coloured plain tights; stockings, leggings or hold ups are not permitted.
- White, grey or black socks.
- Black low-heeled polishable shoes; ballet pumps, boots or trainers are not permitted
- A single, small, plain stud earring in each ear lobe is allowed; visible piercings are not.
- Bracelets, rings or necklaces should not be visible.
- Hoops or dangly earrings, nose studs or stretchers are not permitted
- Make-up must be discreet.

## Sixth Form Expectations:

- Business dress should be worn by all Sixth Form students.

## Guidance For All:

- Plain dark coats are permitted to suit the weather conditions but must be removed for lessons.
- Hijabs should be a plain dark colour.
- No 'hoodies' except for school games issue which may be worn to and from school.
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- Vests or t-shirts worn under shirts for warmth must not be visible.
- Scarves, hats or gloves should not be worn in school.
- No extreme hairstyles; dyed hair must be of a natural colour.
- All items of school clothing should be clearly marked with the student's name.

Final decisions regarding the appropriateness of uniform are at the discretion of the school.

Wearing inappropriate uniform will be sanctioned according to the Behaviour Policy and students may be lent spare uniform to wear. If repeated, the student may be sent home to get changed (in this case parents/carers will be informed).

- Top button and tie worn.
- Black shoes: Polishable and not branded.
- Shirts: Ensure tucked in.
- Skirts: must be regulation (with gold band on waist), pleated and knee length
- Blazer to be worn at all times
- Jewellery – no hoops or dangly earrings, nose stud, stretchers, bracelets, necklaces etc.

## Equipment For All Students:

## Lanyards

Students will be issued with an initial free lanyard and access card; this needs to be worn at all times. This is for identification purposes for both staff, students and visitors and allows secure access to the school site. The card will hold any credit applied through ParentPay for payment of school meals. It will also be needed for printer access.

If the lanyard is lost or damaged, it will need to be replaced. A new card costs £2.50, the holder costs 50p and a lanyard costs £3.00. Purchases may be made via ParentPay.
