

Post 16 September 2021 entry - allocation statement for Bristol Cathedral Choir School

As Bristol Cathedral Choir School is oversubscribed, the admissions criteria published on the School website have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the school.

Number of applications received

807 on-time applications were registered via the admissions portal. The closing date for on-time applications was 12pm on 5th January 2021.

To be eligible to enter the sixth form both internal and external students will be expected to have met the minimum academic entry requirements published on the School website.

The admission number for Year 12 is 100. This is the number of places which will be offered on an annual basis to eligible **external** applicants. i.e students who are not already on roll at BCCS. If fewer students intend to transfer from Year 11, the school will admit over the admission number. The overall capacity for Year 12 is 214.

75 BCCS students transferred from Year 11. The admission number for external applicants is 139.

1 place was required for a student with the school named in their Education, Health and Care Plan. This left 138 places to allocate using the published criteria.

How the initial allocation of places was made

The 138 places have been offered to the following children:

1. Those children who are defined as looked after children and children who were previously looked after but immediately after being looked after became subject to adoption, a child arrangements order, or special guardianship order. (1 place)
2. Those children with a sibling on roll at the time of application at Bristol Cathedral Choir School (Year 7 -11). (5 places)
3. Those children who are a son/daughter of a member of staff at the school.

4. Those children who live within the Bristol Postcode areas BS1 to BS16 and have been randomly allocated. (124 places)
5. Those children who live outside the Bristol Postcode areas BS1 to BS16. (8 places)
