

September 2022 first round allocation statement for Bristol Cathedral Choir School

As Bristol Cathedral Choir School is oversubscribed, the admissions criteria published on the School and Local Authority website have been applied to allocate the places that are available at the school.

Number of applications received

1164 on-time applications (330 first preferences, 473 second preferences and 361 third preferences) have been received for Bristol Cathedral Choir School which has a published admission number of 150.

11 places were required for children with the school named in their Education, Health and Care Plan. This left 140 places to allocate using the published criteria.

How the initial allocation of places was made

The 139 places have been offered to the following children:

1. Those children who are defined as looked after children and children who were previously looked after but immediately after being looked after became subject to adoption, a child arrangements order, or special guardianship order. (10 places)
2. Those children who are probationer choristers at The Cathedral. (7 places)
3. Those children who qualified as Music Specialists. (15 places)
4. Those children who are a son/daughter of a member of staff at BCCS. (4 places)
5. Those children who are at the named Feeder School. (52 places)
6. Those children with a sibling on roll at BCCS at the time of admission. (26 places)
7. Those children who live within the Bristol Postcode areas BS1 to BS16 who have been randomly allocated. (25 places)

8. Those children who live outside the Bristol Postcode areas BS1 to BS16. (None)
